Prerequisites

This course is specifically designed for University of Southern California students who have a solid background of 1-2 years of Modern Standard Arabic (MSA).

Teaching Philosophy

The learning process in this course is proficiency-oriented, with emphasis on the functional use of Arabic and communication in context, focusing on the language skills which are most useful in ECA: listening and speaking, followed by reading and writing. Both the grammar and the subjects covered in class are chosen to help you first survive in ECA, then to express increasingly complex ideas and discuss cultural issues.

In order to encourage the development of listening and speaking skills, all homework assignments will be recorded on Audacity, in addition to more traditional written drills to be handled in the class.

The ECA course is five hours a week. Of this, the first four hours will cover the material in the textbook including new vocabulary, grammar, listening and speaking activities while the fifth hour will focus primarily on cultural awareness by watching Egyptian movies and songs.

Objectives of the Course

In listening, at the end of the course students should have vastly improved their abilities. They should be able to communicate precisely when talking directly with an Egyptian and follow the general plot or topic in Egyptian movies and soap operas, or when a group of Egyptians is speaking amongst themselves.

In speaking, students should be far more comfortable in expressing themselves in ECA, or mixing in MSA where appropriate. They should always try to emulate native speakers and pick up expressions in ECA, rather than translating American English expressions into Arabic, which would be comprehensible for other Americans and some English-speaking Egyptians, but not for the vast majority of Egyptians.

In reading, students should be able to understand most of what is written in Egyptian blogs, plays, and books which are in ECA.

In writing, students should be able to write and fully express themselves in ECA when socially appropriate, but also know when it would be more acceptable to use MSA.

Culturally, students will enhance the knowledge they are picking from Egyptian movies and songs by in class discussions which activate the grammar and vocabulary they have studied.

Expectations

Homework: Students should come to class every day fully prepared and having carefully completed all homework assignments. Students are expected to keep all handouts and organize them so that they can use them in the future. Remember that your homework is an important part of your grade. Homework assignments which are sent late will be corrected but not graded. As homework assignments should be recorded and send by email, you will need to download Audacity software. Audacity is free and very easy to be downloaded. Please, follow this link

You will get individual feedback on your homework in the office hour, while common mistakes that all the students share will be discussed in the class at the beginning of each session.

Attendance: Attendance is extremely important, and after the first two unexcused absences, every further unexcused absence will lower your grade by one grade (from a B to a B-, for instance). The only excused absences are: illness (confirmed by the dean, academic advisor or a doctor) and religious holidays (the instructor needs to be informed at least one week prior to the holiday). Every tardiness of five minutes or more counts as 1/2 of an unexcused absence.

Quizzes: You will have two types of tests: (1) individual oral exams (2) written in-class vocabulary quizzes including listening sections.

1st quiz: Friday, September 28th 2nd quiz: Friday, November 2nd 3rd quiz: Friday, December 7th

Projects: Students will have one video project and one final in-class project. The first project is a 10-minute video which can be done either in small groups or individually. When choosing your groups, make sure that at least one of you has a video camera. The in-class project will be a 10-minute play or skit which you write and act out for the class in groups of 2-3 students. The two projects will be graded on the basis of effort, the use of vocabulary and grammar covered in class, and creativity.

Video projects: Friday, October 19th In-class projects: Friday, November 30th

Final Exam: The final examination will be comprehensive and will test the reading, writing, and listening skills as well as grammar and vocabulary. You will be notified of the time of final exam when the Registrar's Office announces it.

Office Hours: Office hours will be used regularly for giving students feedback on their progress, and going over recorded homework assignments. Students should also take advantage of office hours to work on their weak spots or to address any questions or comments they may have about class.
