

## Invasion of the Body Snatchers:





In the 1950s, a time of conformity and rebellion, scores of writers and filmmakers were blacklisted: prohibited from employment by Hollywood's studios. Some were jailed, cited for contempt of Congress, exiled; others, unable to write under their own names, used non-blacklisted writers as "fronts."

This course will examine their work, over and under the table, and discuss their artistic contributions along with their political ones, looking at everything from Salt of the Earth to Lawrence of Arabia. We'll also look at Invasion of the Body Snatchers, On the Waterfront and other films deeply inflected by the politics of the McCarthy era.

While focusing on 50s and 60s, we will explore a vital and truly contemporary topic: the tensions between politics and art in writing, and the tensions between art and commerce in filmmaking.
