Note: In consideration of continuity of care or needed hours to meet field requirements, students and Field Instructors may plan for interns to work during semester breaks. In these situations, VAC Field recommends that students remain in field for a minimum of 8 hours and a maximum of 12 hours per week to preserve self-care, keep interns in the student role, and ensure full semesters at field placement (not ending early due to extra break hours). These hour limits are recommendations, not policy, and should be used to guide discussions with students and Field Instructors/Preceptors about break hours. The Field Faculty Liaison must be informed of this plan, which should be written in the student's Learning Agreement. For this summer's initial 12-week VAC semester, students are encouraged to discuss with their field instructor ways to accumulate internship hours during the semester breaks both before and after the semester to help meet the 240-hour field practicum requirement.
