ART450 Topics in Advanced Photography

In this course you will develop a semester-long photography project. You will learn research, production and finishing strategies, as well as hone your critical skills at writing and talking about your artwork. The goal of this course is to facilitate self-directed, self-motivated photography practice. The questions that are generated by your project, and your gradual solutions for resolving them, and the realization of either an exhibition or book will be the primary focus of this class. This class features a guest artist critique session, visits to galleries, museums and artist's studios along with reading and discussion.

ART 450 counts toward the Photo Minor.

ART 450 may be repeated for credit by BA and BFA students.
