ART 310: DRAWING 2 IS A LIFE DRAWING CLASS THAT EMPHASIZES OBSERVATION, SKILL ACQUISITION, AND THE EXPLORATION OF INDIVIDUAL IDEAS. IT IS THE STUDY OF THE HUMAN FIGURE RELATING TO FORM AND CONTENT AS WELL AS PSYCHOLOGICAL COMPLEXITY.

CLASS WORK CONSISTS OF DRAWING THE FIGURE, LECTURES, DEMONSTRATIONS, CRITIQUES, READINGS, ANATOMICAL INFORMATION, AND KEEPING A SKETCHBOOK JOURNAL.

STUDENTS WILL ACQUIRE AND EXPAND THEIR KNOWLEDGE OF HISTORICAL AND CONTEMPORARY DRAWING AND PAINTING AND GAIN A RICH VISUAL VOCABULARY TO USE TOWARDS INDIVIDUAL ARTISTIC EXPRESSION.
