If so, this course is for you! It emphasizes the communicative situations and language functions required for job and internship searches and applications. The course parallels the functions studied in second and third semester French language courses and it contextualizes these structures in a business setting together with business vocabulary. You will be acquainted with French economy and corporate life, through assigned readings in English and French, for effective intercultural communication and negotiation.
