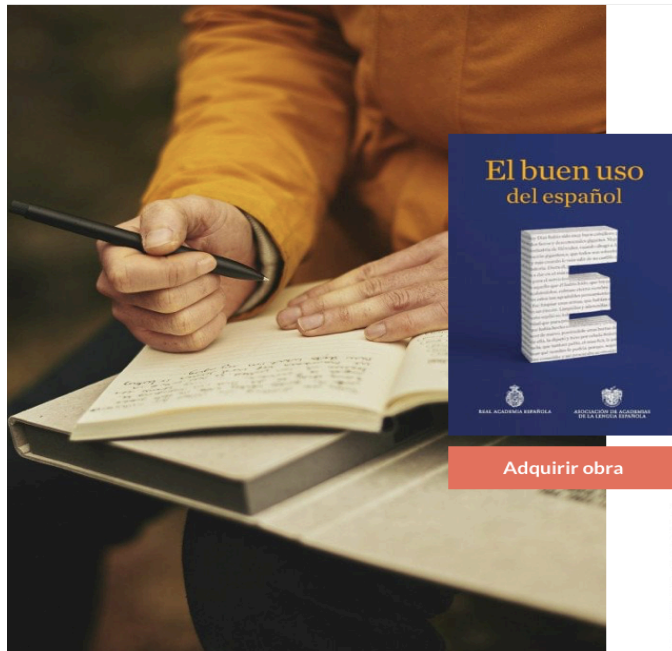

SPAN 412 SPANISH RHETORIC AND STYLE



This course helps to acquire an advanced level of written (and oral) Spanish communication through rhetorical, grammatical and lexical analysis of various kinds of writings, and through composition tasks and assignments involving description, narration, journalistic reporting, argumentation, and exposition. The objectives will be approached from the reading to writing vantage point in the context of reading/listening comprehension and speaking.

Pre-requisite: 1 from SPAN 310 or SPAN 315

Required textbook: Finnemann, M.D. and L. Carbón, *De lector a escritor*. Boston: Heinle & Heinle, 2001.
