Your final grade will be based on attendance, participation, homeworks and exams. Grade percentages: Homeworks 30%, Midterm 30%, Final: 40%.

Course Description: we will cover topics such as the construction of the real numbers, complete metric spaces, compact metric spaces, connected metric spaces, sequences and series of functions.
